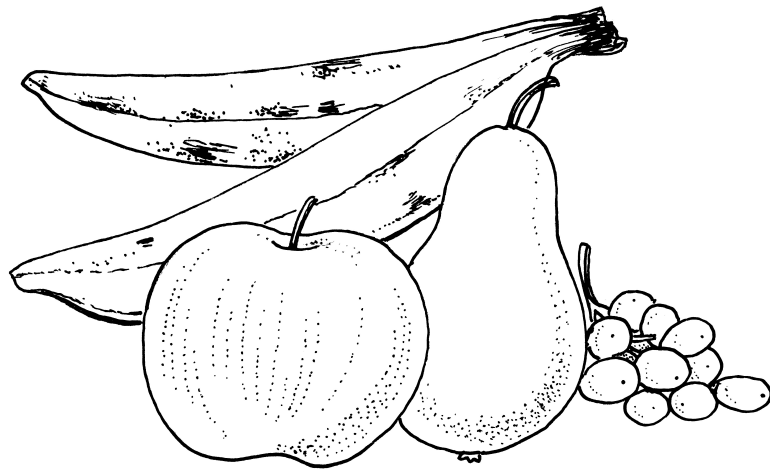

**Sweden** - Sverige

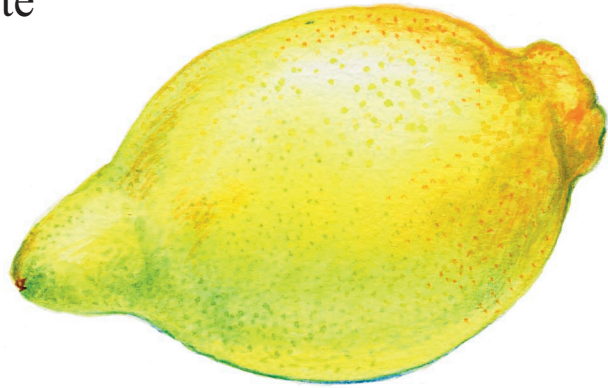
# The Lemon

# The Kiwifruit

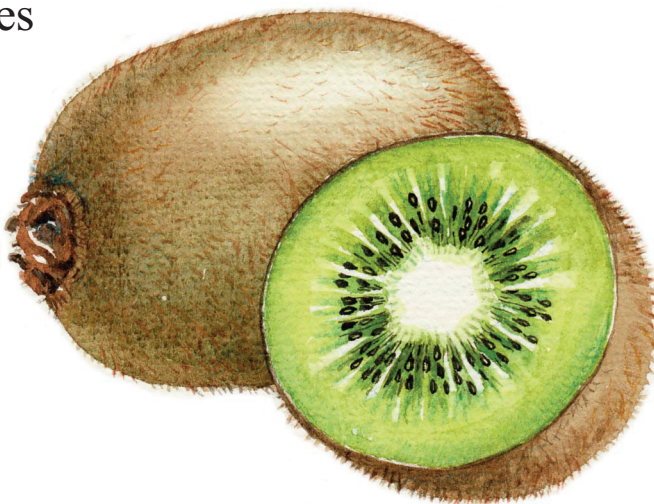
---
